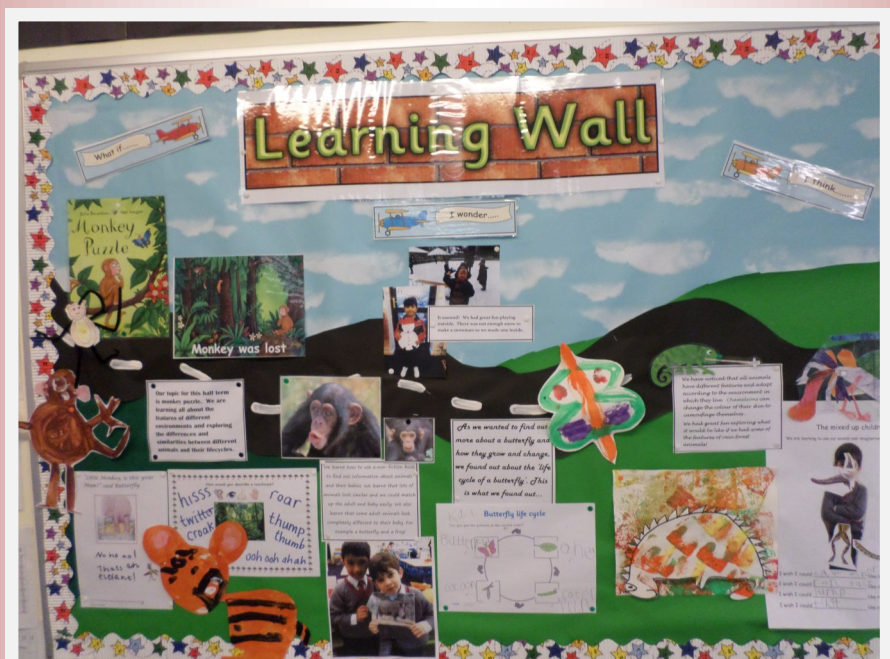

This has been a very busy half-term and the boys have worked very hard.

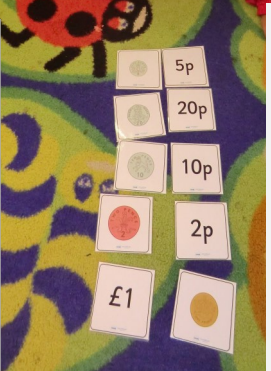
There will be the usual homework to complete but above all, the boys need time to play, rest and sleep.

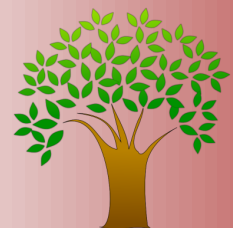

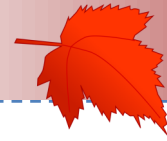

World Book Day—Thursday, 2nd March

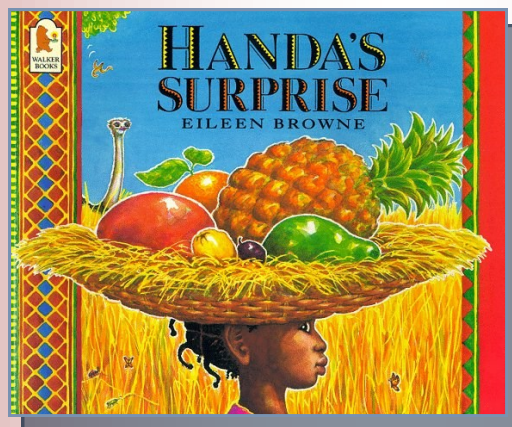
Treetops Purley children are welcome to dress up as a character from their favourite book, to celebrate World Book Day.
