



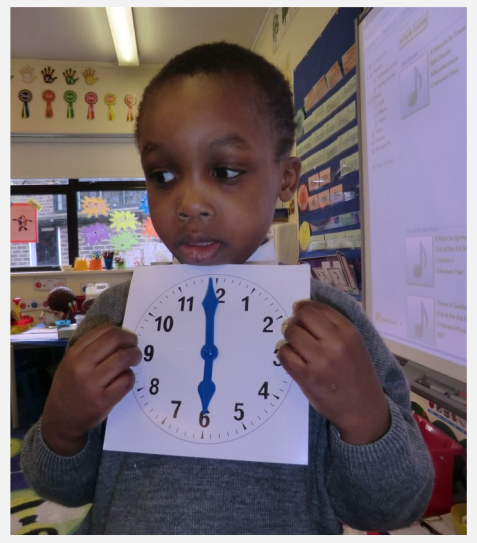

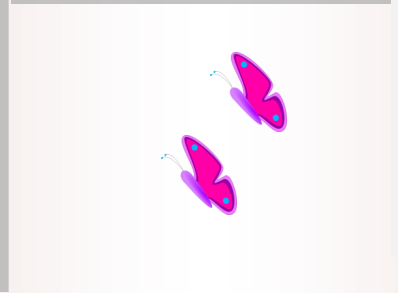
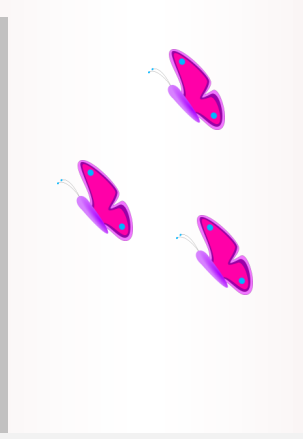


**Spring**
