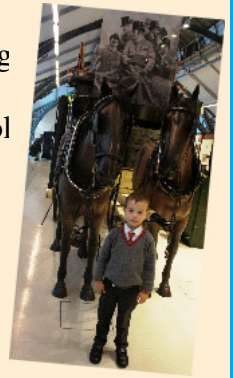

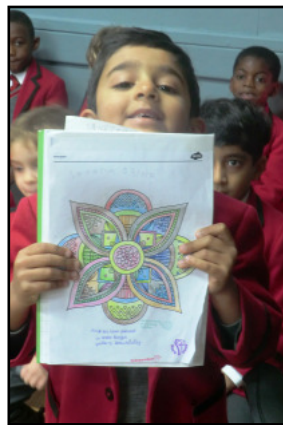
Year 1 Trip to the London Transport Museum

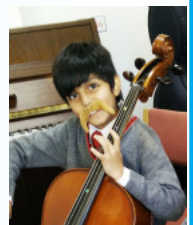
MOVEMBER
