Name: Elizabeth Garrett Anderson

Born: 9 June 1836 in Whitechapel, London, UK

Achievements: First English woman to qualify as a doctor and a Surgeon in Britain
Co-founded the first hospital staffed by women
Co-founded the London School of Medicine for women

Wednesday Assembly

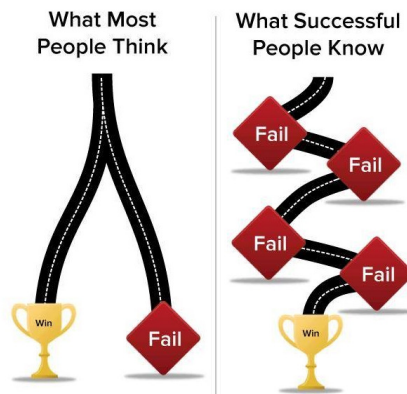
