

Dear Parents







Fantastic work boys. You have worked hard to achieve excellent results. Good luck for next week in the bonus round.









It has been an extremely busy half term and I am sure the boys are looking forward to a well deserved break. **Covid cases** have caused **considerable disruption** this term and we hope that boys and staff who are isolating and/or unwell recover soon and we look forward to seeing you back at school. We will continue to use our **three step** process to inform you of numbers of cases in classes and year groups any **additional measures** we are putting in place. I am pleased to report that many of the pupils in the classes affected have been completing daily lateral flow tests and this has **reduced the spread significantly**.

I would also like to take this opportunity to **thank the staff** for working hard to cover different lessons and the staff at home who are continuing to work remotely. Boys who are well enough have been able to continue with their learning joining online where appropriate.







You will also see **Year 6** have been hard at work with their **Maths Project** - design your own office. **Nicholas, Aiden and Ishaan** have made a great effort with this thinking about the cost of furniture, measurements the space. Well done, some exciting ideas and very creative too!

It has been a very **exciting** week across the **Early Years** as we have all been learning about the **Lunar New Year** and we hope all our families who celebrate have had a wonderful week.

In our **South Croydon Pre-School** class the children listened to the story of **'The tiger who came to tea'** in honour of the year of the tiger and had a tea party with their own decorated biscuits. They have also enjoyed making paper plate tigers, red lanterns and took part in a celebratory new year dance. In our **Purley Pre-School** class the children's favourite activity was parading their own **Chinese dragon puppet!** Throughout the week, each child had a chance to work on the **puppet** through painting and decorating or carrying the puppet. The dragon puppet will be **on display** in our classroom for everyone to see until the end of term - come and visit, **he is magnificent!**



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This week **Reception** have also been learning about the **Lunar New Year** and its traditions. On Tuesday they went out on a very **sunny walk to Upper Woodcote Village Green**. They used musical instruments and a **homemade dragon head** to replicate the famous **Dragon dance**. The boys showed **amazing rhythm** as they moved to the beat of their accompanying instruments. **Faris** then sang a traditional **Chinese New Year song** that his family sing to all the boys, which then sparked an impromptu talent show with boys showing how well they can sing songs in different languages.





In our **South Croydon Kindergarten class** the children have participated in different **Lunar New Year activities** such as **mixed coloured rice play** using chop sticks for our fine motor skills and enjoying using play dough mats with **red** play dough. They have been making **celebration cards** and listening to traditional stories. In our **Purley Kindergarten class** the children have also become fascinated with **spiders** this week. **Mrs Hollands** has talked to the children about spiders, how they spin their webs, have **8 legs and 8 eyes**. They watched a clip of spiders spinning their webs and then had a turn at **making their own webs**, using paper plates and wool.
