A Message from SLT



It has been another busy week at Cumnor House School for Boys'. Many boys have completed their first assessments and series of interviews at 11+ and 13+ including the ISEB Pre-Tests held at our school; the senior School examination window is well and truly open. As such, all pupils in Years 3 to 8 have recently completed PASS surveys, which asks pupils to reflect on 'Pupil's Attitudes to Self and School'. These assessments will help us better understand your son's mindset towards school and if they are confident and motivated to learning, particularly for some, in what can be an anxious period approaching senior school assessments. The program will also identify barriers to learning in order to ensure student wellbeing and positive outcomes at a whole school, class, and individual level.

Sadly, as the cold wet days draw in, we farewell a fantastic football season. However, we look forward to the approaching rugby season and hope to be dazzled as we were with the recent Rugby World Cup.

On a more personal note, it is clear that road works and congestion have interrupted the journeys of our families, to and from school. This can bring a level of unwanted frustration to the start of the day. It has been disheartening to hear an account of unkind exchanges from Cumnor parents towards one another at drop off and pick up. Compassion and Integrity stand at the very forefront of the values that we aim to instil within our boys. We kindly ask that these virtues are also embraced by all members of the Cumnor Community, as staff and parents set the standard for our young learners to follow.

On Monday the Upper School pupils were excited to welcome Andrew Newlands, MD, founder and owner of the Monty Bojangles Co. and importantly, old boy of Cumnor House School. Andrew was a true raconteur, recounting his formative years in the red blazer. His talk, with a focus on 'Careers', touched on the qualities, skills and attributes that he has developed ultimately leading to his success. It was inspiring to see our very own Cumnor Way values at the fore of what has been important to him. Andrew was humble in his reliving of his Cumnor Journey and subsequent success, telling us of how an "ordinary / normal" pupil became Head Boy.

Andrew then shared his secrets of the trade around interview prep. The boys were motivated to learn that there are 3 simple ingredients:

- Deliver differences
- Appear helpful





It was compelling to witness the emotion Andrew experienced touring the school at the conclusion of his assembly. Some 30 years on from hanging up the Cumnor blazer, he could vividly recall moments that shaped his future- his drive, creativity and passion for music in particular.

Thank you Andrew for sharing your experiences (and amazing truffles), our boys, I am sure will use your story in writing their very own next chapter.

We would highly recommend a visit to this local restaurant. If you are interested in creative East Asian cuisine book a table at <u>Toriton Izakaya</u>.












Nativity: If your child does not attend Nursery on that day they can still come in and perform please drop them off at least 20 minutes before the start and they can leave with you at the end of the performance.



Purley Pre-School


