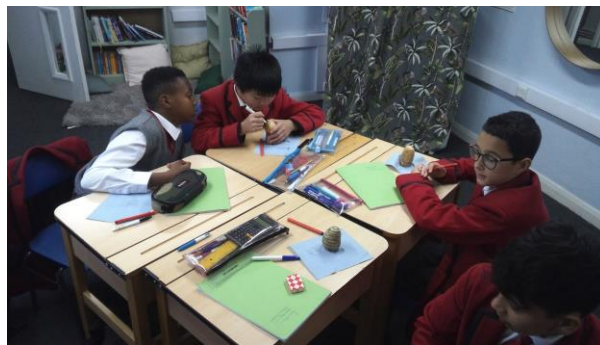
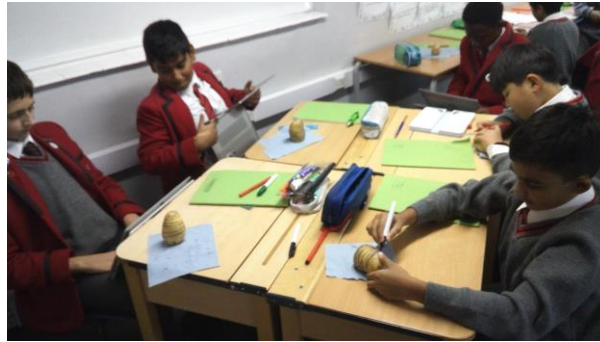






## Year 7 Geography

6. Your mouthguard is now ready to use!

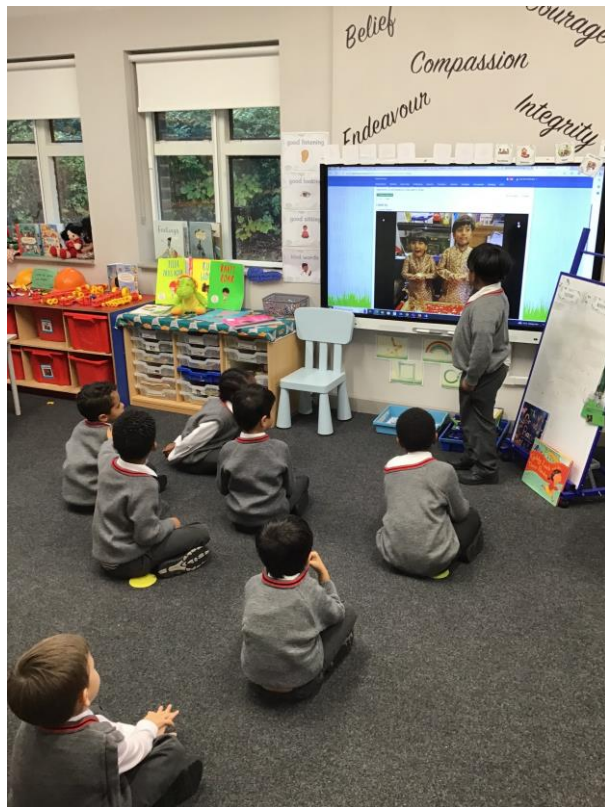












## Pre-School
